What does it cover? Update to ongoing health alert

FA Announcement:

Following the Government's announcement today, for people to avoid social contact and gatherings where possible, we are now advising that all grassroots football in England is postponed for the foreseeable future.

Throughout this period, we have taken Government advice with the priority being the health and wellbeing of all. We will continue to work closely with the grassroots game during this time.

We are in regular communication with the Government and the situation within English football at all levels remains under regular review. Further updates will follow as needed.

As a result of the advice from the FA, as of 1830hrs 16 March, **all OMYFL fixtures are immediately suspended.**

It remains a fluid situation and we will not be speculating on when, or if, the league and cup programmes may be played.

We will continue to follow government and PHE advice and if and when that became more positive, we will review the decision at that time and update teams via Full Time, and the OMYFL website.

We wish to thank everyone involved in our league for their support, and wish them good health in the testing times ahead.
