



Referee reporting (Full-Time)

After each match for which you have been appointed, you should complete the League match report within 48 hours.

Note: this is in addition to your usual discipline match report that you do via Whole Game System (WGS).

New functionality has been added ahead of the 2021/22 season allowing referees to submit reports into FA Full-Time.

Access

All referees (see **note** below) can now sign into Full-Time using their FA Account and do not require a FA Full-Time Login invite (sign in using the same details they would use to submit discipline via Whole Game System). From within FA Full-Time, they will only see fixtures they have been assigned to by the league.

Note: to use this functionality:

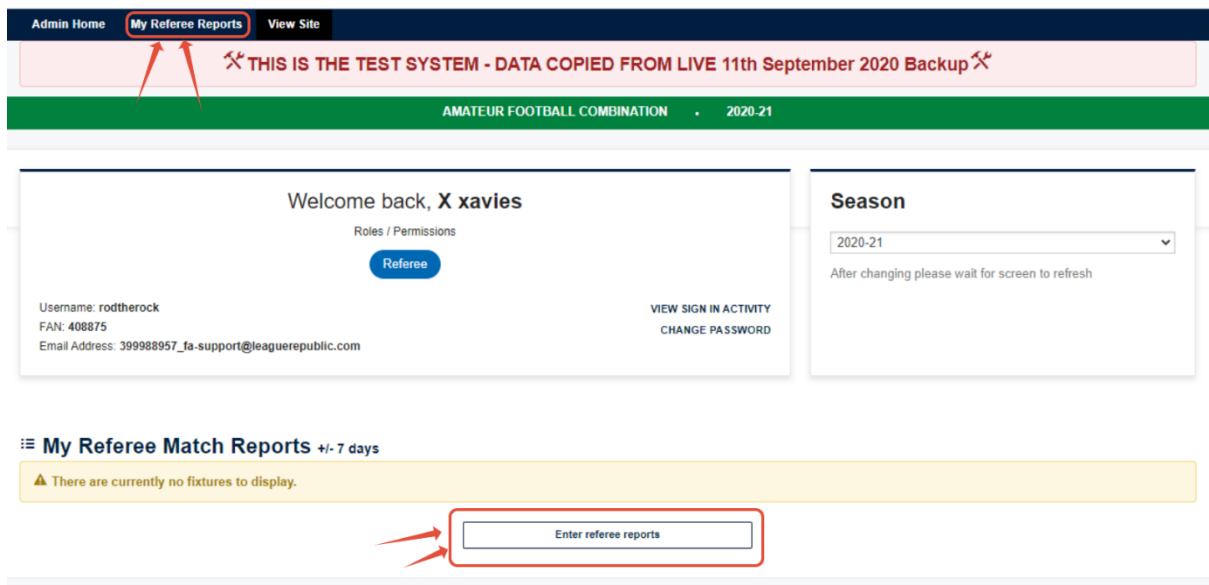
- Leagues must have linked the Full-Time record for a referee to their WGS record
- Leagues must have changed their security settings to allow referees access to complete reports
- Referees must be registered with their relevant County FA
- Referees must have a single FAN (duplicates will need to be merged)

Signing into Full-Time

Sign into Full-Time using the following link:

After signing in, the referee will be taken to the "Admin Home" page whereby any fixtures in the last 7 days (or upcoming 7 days) will appear. Please click "Enter Referee Reports" or "My Referee Reports" in order to access all of your reports



Please note: "My Referee Reports" tab will only show fixtures whereby the referee has been assigned to the fixture as a referee. If the referee was expecting to see a fixture which does not appear within the tab then they should contact the relevant league who can assign them to the fixture.

Editing a report

In order to edit a report, after accessing "my referee report" tab the referee should click "Edit Report"

- complete 6x FA Questions (standard on all referee reports on Full-time) – see below
- any extra league questions – see below
