

Referee Appointments



- For the 2023/24 season we dramatically increased the number of appointments we were able to make (some weekends over 75% coverage) and hope to continue a similar trend this season
- We will continue to prioritise older age groups and generally appoint referees from U21 down to U13s fixtures, and possibly U11-U12 depending on availability and age of referees. As well as a few games on Saturday
- Appointments usually out from Full Time / Centre Circle by midweek
- Spare games with be advertised from Centre Circle

- Clubs must use you as the league appointed referee
- Clubs must contact you by phone, text or email and ensure a response is received. This should be done 3 days before match, and definitely by Friday evening.
- If a club fails to confirm with you, you are under no obligation to attend the fixture
- If a clubs fails to contact you as the referee and the details of the match (e.g. KO time or venue) change and you attend the fixture at the original time or at the original venue, you will still receive the match fee
- Payment must be made within 48 hours of the fixture
- For postponements on the day clubs must contact you by phone (email, WhatsApp or text is not sufficient)
